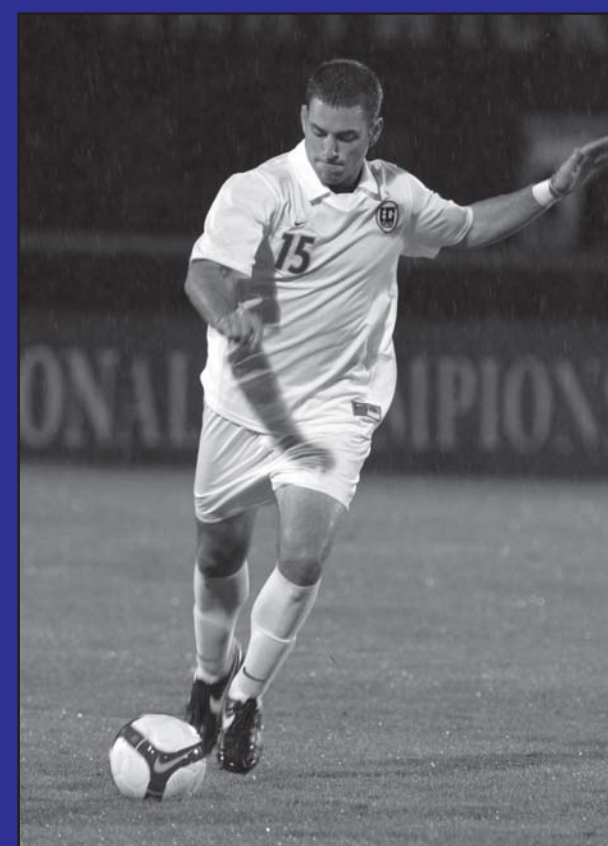
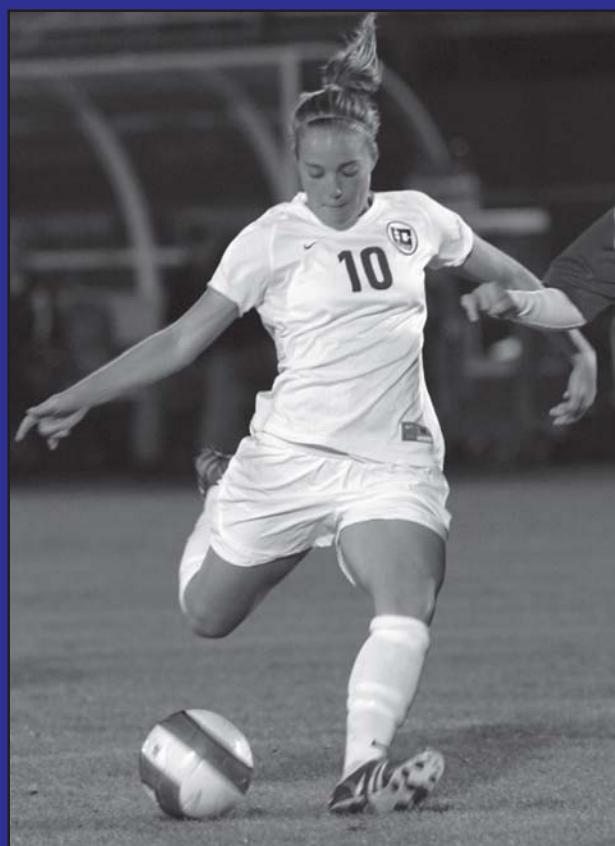

# Hartwick College Soccer Camp

**Session I: July 11-15**  
Boys and Girls

**Session II: July 17-21**  
Ages 8-18

The 37th annual Hartwick College Soccer Camp is open to boys and girls ages 8-18. The camp reflects Hartwick's fine tradition in soccer and offers young players a chance to improve their technique and tactical knowledge of the game. **Every camper will receive a NIKE ball and a NIKE camp T-shirt.**

Morning sessions focus on functional training that reflects individual and group situations pertaining to the game. Dribbling, shooting, heading, tackling and receiving are among the individual skills the camp teaches. **The goalkeepers will receive individual technical training.**

Afternoon sessions focus on collective tactics, team preparation, and small-sided games. Evening games will give players the opportunity to put their skills to the test during full-sided competitive games.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

**FEES:** Camp tuition includes a **non-refundable** application fee (\$35 for both residents and commuters), excess accident insurance, instruction, use of College facilities, a NIKE camp T-shirt and a NIKE soccer ball. The cost for residents includes lodging and meals. The cost for commuters includes lunch and dinner. **NOTE:** Hartwick summer sports camps offer a 10 percent discount to children of Hartwick employees, Coaches Club members, and alumni. **In compliance with NCAA regulations, this discount applies only to children who have not yet started the tenth grade.** Please complete the appropriate information on the application form.

**TEAM DISCOUNTS:** A variety of discounts are available for groups or teams wishing to attend the soccer camp. In order to receive the team discount, **all applications must be sent in at the same time.** For more information, contact the Hartwick College Summer Sports Camp Office at 607-431-4700, or email [sportscamps@hartwick.edu](mailto:sportscamps@hartwick.edu).

**REFUND POLICY:** A full refund will be given to any camper if the camp is filled or cancelled. If a camper withdraws prior to the starting date (registration), all payments **except the non-refundable application fee will be refunded.** Once the camp begins, there are no refunds made for late arrivals or early departures. Refunds based on medical conditions will be issued as conditions warrant.

**ROOM AND BOARD:** Campers will be housed in supervised student residence halls, two campers per room. Please contact the camp office for details. Roommate preference must be stated on the application form. Meals will be served in the Commons, the College's centrally located dining hall. **Linens are not provided.** Campers should bring linen, towels, a swimsuit, a combination lock for use in the locker room, toiletries, and appropriate athletic and casual clothing. All campers wishing to use Hartwick's indoor pool will be skill tested at the beginning of camp.

**INSURANCE:** Parents are advised to provide health insurance for their children attending the soccer camp at the College. If the services of a physician or Fox Hospital of Oneonta are required, charges will be made directly to the parents. A \$2,500 accident policy is provided for all campers (this is excess coverage beyond parental insurance).

**HEALTH REQUIREMENTS/FACILITIES:** The Perrella Wellness Center provides health care and emergency services 24 hours a day while the camp is in session. As required by the New York State Department of Health, all campers must submit, on forms provided by the College, **complete documentation of immunizations and a physical examination within the past year,** as well as a **Medication Form** completed and signed by the camper's health care provider. This form **MUST** include all over-the-counter and/or prescription medications. Compliance with this regulation is a prerequisite for admission to the summer programs.

**DAMAGE POLICY:** Violation of camp regulations may result in immediate dismissal from camp. Actions will be taken to secure reimbursement for damages to Hartwick College property. Should a camper be dismissed for any disciplinary reasons, there will be no refund issued.

**HOW TO APPLY:** Campers have the option of applying online at <http://www.hartwick.edu/sportscamps.xml> or fill out the application form completely and return it with the non-refundable application fee of \$35. The balance of the fee is due before or at registration. Upon receipt of your non-refundable application fee, additional camp information will be sent, along with a **Health Examination/Parental Consent Form** and **Medication Sheet** (forms are also available online) which must be completed and returned **prior to registration.** No camper will be allowed to participate in camp activities until these forms are received and approved by the College.

*(Hartwick Summer Programs are duly licensed by the New York State Department of Health and are in full compliance with all safety and health codes relating to the operation of summer "overnight camps" for campers under the age of 18.)*



**MATT VERNI '98**

Matt Verni will be entering his 4th year as head women's soccer coach at Hartwick this fall. He returned to Oyaron Hill after being introduced as head coach on March 19, 2007.

Verni, a 1998 Hartwick graduate, returned to his alma mater after serving as the head men's soccer coach at the University of New Haven for three years. During his time with the Chargers, Verni led them to a 16-36-4 mark on the Division II level, including a 6-11-3 record in 2006. Verni was named the 2006 East Coast Conference Coach of the Year and he coached five all-ECC performers while at New Haven.

Prior to his stint at New Haven, Verni served two years (2002-04) as an assistant coach for the men's program at Division I University of New Hampshire, where the Wildcats posted an 18-14-2 mark in his two years at Durham. He was instrumental in back-to-back top five New England rankings (5th in 2002, 2nd in 2003).

Verni played four years of Division I men's soccer at Hartwick from 1994-97, lettering in 1996. During his playing career, he was a member of the Hawks' 1995 squad that advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament with a 3-2 victory over St. John's in the opening round of competition.

After graduating from Hartwick, Verni served as an assistant coach for the women's program at Division I St. Bonaventure for one year. In June 2001, he returned to his alma mater as an assistant coach for the Hawks' men's program for one year. In 2001, Hartwick finished 12-8 overall and was ranked as high as second in the region and 16th in the country at one point.



**JOHN SCOTT**

John Scott is entering his first season as Hartwick's head men's soccer coach. A native of Banff, Scotland, and former player at 'Wick, Scott returns to Oyaron Hill after serving the past nine seasons as the top assistant at Binghamton University. He is just the 7th head coach in the 54-year history of the Hartwick men's soccer program.

At Binghamton, Scott assisted in the management and development of all phases of the Bearcats' program including recruiting, training, match preparation, team academics, and alumni and community relations. During his stay at BU, he was a key factor in the team's Division I success. After their first two years competing at the Division I level in 2001 and 2002, the Bearcats went 69-37-29 in the past seven years with two appearances in the NCAA Tournament, two America East Conference titles, and six trips to the America East Tournament finals.

As a Hartwick player, Scott donned the blue and white in 1996 starting all 18 games. He finished the campaign ranked 2nd in assists and tied for 4th in scoring with a goal and five helpers. After his freshman season, Scott returned to his native Scotland to compete on the semi-professional level for Fraserburgh FC and Buckie Thistle FC from 1997-2000. He earned a bachelor's degree in 2000 from the University of Abertay in Dundee, Scotland, in the field of sports coaching.

Scott holds coaching certifications from the Scottish Football Association as well as National Soccer Coaches Association of America National, Advanced National, and Premier Diplomas.
