# This is Hartwick College



Founded in 1797, Hartwick is a small, private, liberal arts and sciences college offering more than 45 diverse academic programs. Hartwick's expansive Liberal Arts in Practice curriculum merges traditional liberal arts study, personalized teaching, and experiential learning approaches to emphasize Connecting the Classroom to the World. Add to that a wide range of off-campus internships, collaborative research, study-abroad opportunities, and our unique January Term, and you are virtually guaranteed to be connected and ready for the opportunities that lie ahead.

A Hartwick education is a personalized education. With a 12-to-1 student-to-faculty ratio and an average class size of 18, students really get to know their professors. Professors are mentors who give students the confidence to succeed in whatever they choose to do. More than 40 percent of Hartwick students complete an internship for academic credit and 60 percent study off campus or abroad before graduating. Hartwick faculty lead off-campus programs all over the world during our January Term, allowing students to study in real-life contexts.

Located in the northern foothills of the Catskill Mountains, Hartwick enrolls 1,480 students from 36 states and 20 countries. Its hillside campus, with a 30-mile view of the beautiful Susquehanna Valley, overlooks Oneonta, NY—a small town recognized as one of the country's top college towns. Oneonta is centrally located in New York State, equidistant from Binghamton, Albany, Kingston, and Utica, 190 miles northwest of New York City, and 20 miles southwest of historic Cooperstown, home of the National Baseball Hall of Fame.

Hartwick has been named a "Best College in the Northeastern Region" by *The Princeton Review* and a "College of Distinction," one of a group of colleges known nationally for their engaged students, great teaching, vibrant community, and successful outcomes. More than one-quarter of the student body participates in one of the College's 17 athletic teams, and 65+ student organizations provide additional social outlets.

Hartwick has a strong financial aid program, which helps bring costs within reach for most qualified students. Approximately 98% of our students receive financial assistance. Beyond need-based aid, a wide range of scholarships is available for academic achievement and school and community involvement. Nearly 80% of students work on campus. Hartwick's Office of Financial Aid and Affordability works individually with students and their families to help them find solutions that fit their needs.
