

Instructions for Installing SPSS 17 from the Hartwick network

Note: Faculty, staff and returning students have the ability to install the newest version of SPSS from the Hartwick network. New students should contact the Technology Resource Center if they need to install SPSS.

This version of SPSS is for Windows only. Mac users can either install a copy of Windows on their Mac and then install SPSS, or run SPSS from the Hartwick application server. Contact the Technology Resource Center x-4357 for assistance.

1. From your network-connected computer, click Start, Run
2. Type `\\einstein\spss\17` and click okay (if you are logged on to the Hartwick domain, you will have access to this folder. If you are not, you will be prompted for your Hartwick username and password)
3. Double click the `Setup.exe` file
4. Click the first option "Install SPSS Statistics 17"
5. During the install wizard, select "**Site License**" as the type of license and click next
6. Select that you accept the license agreement and click next
7. Continue to click next when prompted
8. Enter your name for the user name (your full name is fine)
9. Enter Hartwick College for the organization
10. **Leave the serial number field blank**
11. Click next when prompted
12. Click Install when prompted
13. At the end of the install you will come to the License and registration screen
14. **Uncheck the box for "Register SPSS online"**
15. Click OK
16. The Product Authorization Window will open
17. Click Cancel
18. Click Yes to cancel the product authorization wizard
19. Back in the original SPSS install window, click exit
20. **You now need to license your copy of SPSS. Be sure the `\\einstein\spss\17` folder is open,**
21. Double click the file named `spssauth.bat`. That will license your copy (takes about 5 seconds)
22. Close all windows.

Launch SPSS from Start, All Programs, SPSS Inc, Statistics 17.

If you still have an older version of SPSS installed, you may wish to uninstall it from the Add/Remove Programs option in the Control Panel.
