## At a Glance

<p><b>First Year Seminar</b></p>	<p>Complete a First Year Seminar (minimum 3 credits) &amp; Connections</p>	
<p><b>Writing Competency</b></p>	<p>Attain Writing Level 4</p>	<p>Achieve Level 4 on the Placement Exam, satisfy WL3 component of a course, or earn A- or better in Engl 110</p>
<p><b>Quantitative/ Formal Reasoning</b></p>	<p>Complete a course (minimum 3 credits) with a Quantitative or Formal Reasoning (QFR) designation</p>	<p>Choose a QFR designated course that explores or makes significant use of mathematics, formal logical reasoning or computers for analysis of mathematical, social-scientific, or scientific data.</p>
<p><b>Foreign Language*</b></p>	<p>-complete a 6 credit elementary sequence (101 and 102) OR          -complete a 3 credit intermediate course (201) OR          -complete elementary course with corresponding off-campus program (6 credits) OR          -complete elementary course with corresponding on-campus culture course (6 credits)</p>	
<p><b>Breadth and Integration</b></p>	<p>Complete at least 3 courses, (totaling at least 9 credits), in each of the College's three academic divisions:          Humanities          Physical &amp; Life Sciences          Social &amp; Behavioral Sciences</p>	<p><b>Humanities**:</b>          3 credits must have ILS or EL designation.</p> <p><b>Physical &amp; Life Sciences:</b>          Of the 9 credits, complete at least 3 credits in chemistry or physics, at least 3 credits in biology or geology, and at least one of the courses must have a weekly lab.</p> <p><b>Social &amp; Behavioral Sciences:</b>          Courses must be in at least two different departments. 3 credits must have Integrative Learning Seminar (ILS) or Experiential Learning (EL) designation.</p>
<p><b>Depth in Discipline</b></p>	<p>Complete the requirements for one Primary Major Program or a student-designed Individual Student Program (ISP).</p>	
<p><b>Senior Capstone</b></p>	<p>Complete (minimum 3 credits) a departmentally (or ISP) determined Senior Capstone.</p>	
<p><b>Physical Education</b></p>	<p>Complete two 1 credit skills courses.</p>	

\* Courses used to satisfy the Foreign Language Requirement may not be used to satisfy any other general education requirement, with the exception that students may meet the experiential requirement in the Humanities Division with an off-campus program of a minimum of 15 days off campus.

\*\* Courses at Writing Level 1, 2, and 2b (English 101, 110, and 111) do not satisfy the Breadth and Integration requirement in the Humanities.
