


Tips for Using a Calling Card with Dial-Up Hartwick

For use with Windows XP

Although there are wizards and dialup rules for setting up calling cards, many people find them difficult. Instead of using those, it may be simpler to just enter the entire string of numbers into the dial-up phone number area where you currently see the Hartwick number.

The sample below is following the guide for a particular calling card. You must read the back of your card and be sure that the sequence of numbers required for your card is followed. It should look something like the following:

9,1800225ZZZZ,,,,6074314015,,XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX



1. A 9 or 8 is used at the beginning of the numbers only if you are staying in a location (hotel) that requires dialing 9 or 8 to get an outside line. You may have to alter that for different locations. If not required, remove that and the comma following it.
2. Enter the number from the back of your card that you must dial first (usually a 1800 number).
3. Enter ,,.,.
4. Enter 6074314015 which is the number you are dialing (Hartwick's modem pool).
5. Enter ,,.
6. Enter your calling card and pin number where the XXXXXs appear. The numbers are usually located on the front of your card.

Just be sure you replace the instructions and numbers above with the correct numbers from your own card. FYI, the commas are pauses usually required for the call to be completed.
