

Setting up VPN for Windows XP

1. Go to Control Panel and open "Network and Connections"
2. Start the Network Connection Wizard: double click on "Create New Connection"
Just click "Next" on this intro page.
3. On the "Network Connection Type" page, select your connection type. Since we are only interested in VPN, select "Connect to the network at my workplace" and click "Next".
4. On the "Network Connection" page, select the item "Virtual Private Network connection" and click "Next".
5. On the "Connection Name" page, type "Hartwick College VPN" in the "Company Name" field and click "Next".
6. On the "Public Network" page, select your dialing option depending on you're setup. If you are running a cable modem or some other network, select: "Do not dial the initial connection".
If you are using a modem, select with modem connection you wish to use.
(Obviously, this must already be in place before you begin this procedure. See item 0.)

Click "Next".

7. On the "VPN Server Selection" page, type "vpn.hartwick.edu" and click "Next".
8. If you see a "Connection Availability" dialog box, check "My Use Only" to prevent other users of your computer from seeing the VPN configuration.
9. On the "Completing the New Connection" page, click the "Finish" button to complete the creation of the VPN connection.
10. An "Initial Connection" box will pop up and what it says depends on your connection to the Internet. Do not connect.
11. Select the newly created VPN connection icon and right click and open "Properties".
 - o Select "Options Tab"
 - o Check "Include Windows logon Domain"

When you go back and try to connect to VPN, make sure that under domain it says Hartwick.

12. Select the newly created VPN connection icon and right click and open "Properties".
 - o Select "Networking Tab"
 - o Select "Internet Protocol (TCP/IP)" and click "Properties" button
 - o Click the "Advanced" button
 - o Under the "General" tab, make sure that "Use default gateway on remote network" is **not** checked. Click "Ok" on this and all previous windows.

In order to connect to VPN all you must do is double-click this new connection. After authenticating using your Hartwick E-mail username and password, all information going to Hartwick will use the VPN connection, and all traffic that is not for Hartwick will use your normal gateway.
