<u>Day Use/Overnight Rentals:</u>

Our summer rental season runs from June 1st through mid-August each year.

Spaces for groups of all sizes are available for reservations at Pine Lake. Whether you are staying for a few hours to a few weeks we can assist with accommodating you group needs.

Day use facilities include sheltered areas such as the Pavilion, Outdoor Stage, Vaudevillian, Field Station, and cabins or various spaces around the grounds.

Overnight accommodations can be made with prior reservations in one of our cabins which sleep anywhere from 1–16 people. All cabins have private kitchen, bath, include wifi, use of the facilities, and have single beds. Linens do not come with cabins, but can be offered for an additional fee.

Our Mission:


