CHECKLIST OF THE VASCULAR FLORA OF PINE LAKE

INTRODUCTION

The Pine Lake property consists of approximately 1100 acres located roughly seven miles east of Oneonta, New York in Delaware County. It was purchased by Hartwick College in the Spring of 1971. The property, consisting of many distinct vegetation types, is a most interesting area for biological studies. An open mountain bog (Mud Lake) and a wooded mountain stream (Shelley Brook) can be found among mixed woods north of Pine Lake Road (see Map I). Major areas south of Pine Lake Road include spring-fed Pine Lake, an alder bog, a hemlock swamp, mixed woodlands, and open fields (see Map II).

A preliminary checklist was made in 1971, in which 75 families were represented with approximately 270 species. This list excluded fall flowering plants and grasses. From 1971 through 1975 collections were made throughout the growing season to supplement the preliminary list. The 1975 checklist now contains 291 genera with 518 species and subspecific taxa represented in 94 families. The collection is presently housed in the Hoysradt Herbarium, Hartwick College.

SCIENTIFIC NAMES

Each species is denoted by a scientific name. The scientific name consists of three parts - genus, species, and author citation. The genus and species are either in Latin or are Latinized. The author citation denotes the person who first

described the plant. All of the scientific names are believed to be legitimate in accordance with the International Code of Botanical Nomenclature.

COMMON NAMES


Most of the common names selected for the checklist were extracted from Gray's Manual of Botany, Peterson's Field Guide to Wildflowers or Seymour's Flora of Vermont. An attempt was made to select the "best" common name, although it is well understood that common names lack the precision of scientific names.


