IT'S AN HONOR TO BE WITH YOU TODAY. A DAY I'VE BEEN LOOKING
FORWARD TO SINCE THE MOMENT I WAS SELECTED TO BECOME THE

11TH PRESIDENT OF HARTWICK COLLEGE.

AS I SAID TO ALL OF OUR NEW STUDENTS DURING THE

MATRICULATION CEREMONIES, WE ARE STARTING OUR JOURNEYS

TOGETHER. AND, FOR EACH OF US, INCLUDING ME, THAT IS BOTH

SUPER EXCITING AND SUPER SCARY. WHILE THERE ARE GOING TO BE

MANY AMAZING TIMES, IT WILL BE HARD.

SO, WHILE I PROMISE TO BE BRIEF, I THOUGHT I'D OFFER A PERSONAL STORY TO REINFORCE AN ATTRIBUTE I THINK WE ALL SHOULD STRIVE TO DEMONSTRATE – AND THAT IS PERSISTENCE.

MY PERSONAL STORY OF PERSISTENCE RELATES TO THIS RING I WEAR

ON MY RIGHT HAND.

IT WAS MY DAD'S RING. HIS FATHER – MY GRANDFATHER – WAS AN IMMIGRANT FROM UKRAINE AND CAME TO BROOKLYN WITH MY DAD'S MOTHER, HAVING NO MONEY AND NO FORMAL EDUCATION.

THEY HAD THREE CHILDREN, MY DAD BEING THE YOUNGEST BY FAR.

MY DAD'S TWO OLDER SIBLINGS DID NOT GO TO COLLEGE. MY DAD,

THOUGH, SHOWED ACADEMIC PROMISE AND SO MY GRANDFATHER,

WHO WAS A RELIGIOUS MAN, ENROLLED HIM AT A FREE YESHIVA OR

JEWISH SCHOOL IN BROOKLYN WHICH WAS KNOWN TO BE QUITE

GOOD.

PROBLEM WAS, MY DAD DIDN'T WANT TO GO TO A JEWISH SCHOOL.

HE WANTED TO BE IN SCHOOL WITH THE KIDS IN THE NEIGHBORHOOD.

SO, IN 9TH GRADE, HE KICKED HIS FEET UP ON THE DESK, OFFERED HIS

TEACHER SOME CHOICE WORDS, AND GOT HIMSELF EXPELLED. WELL,

THAT DIDN'T SIT WELL WITH MY GRANDFATHER WHO CUT HIM OFF

ENTIRELY – REFUSING TO TALK TO HIM FOR WHAT, AS YOU'LL SEE,

TURNED OUT TO BE 7 YEARS.

THE THING IS, MY DAD DID WANT TO LEARN, HE DID WANT TO BECOME ECONOMICALLY MOBILE, HE DID WANT TO MAKE AN IMPACT - SO, WITH NO SUPPORT AT HOME - HE WORKED ODD JOBS, HE SOUGHT OUT HIGH SCHOOL TEACHERS WHO COULD OFFER HIM GUIDANCE, FOUND HIS WAY TO HUNTER COLLEGE -- A FREE COLLEGE IN THE BRONX. DESPITE HIS AMBITION, HE WAS WORRIED. HIS FATHER STILL WASN'T TALKING TO HIM, OR GIVING HIM ANY OF THE LITTLE MONEY HE HAD, HE HAD NO OTHER RELATIVES WHO WENT TO COLLEGE TO GIVE HIM GUIDANCE, AND MOST OF HIS FRIENDS FROM THE NEIGHBORHOOD WERE NOT GOING TO COLLEGE. BUT HE PERSISTED – AND EVERY STEP OF THE WAY HE FACED OBSTACLES. MONEY FOR THE LONG SUBWAY RIDES FROM BROOKLYN TO THE BRONX AND BACK, MONEY FOR FOOD, NOT HAVING A CLEAR SENSE OF WHAT PATH TO PURSUE, FEELING LIKE HE DIDN'T BELONG.

AGAIN, THOUGH, HE PERSISTED. IN FOUR YEARS, HE MADE IT TO
GRADUATION DAY. AND, ON THAT DAY, HIS FATHER SHOWED UP, WITH
THIS RING WHICH HE WORE FROM THAT DAY FORWARD.

UNTIL, A FEW MONTHS AGO WHEN MY DAD WAS IN THE HOSPITAL

AND WE DIDN'T KNOW WHETHER HE WOULD MAKE IT. HE ASKED ME

IF THERE IS ANYTHING OF HIS THAT I WOULD WANT – A DIFFICULT

QUESTION FOR A SON TO HEAR. I SAID THE ONLY THING I WANTED

WAS THAT RING AND THE POWER OF PERSISTENCE IT REPRESENTED.

NOW, LIKE MY DAD, AND LIKE ME, AND LIKE FACULTY, STAFF AND RETURNING STUDENTS HERE TODAY, YOU ARE GOING TO HAVE MOMENTS, DAYS, MAYBE WEEKS WHERE YOU ARE GOING TO QUESTION WHETHER YOU MADE THE RIGHT DECISION IN COMING TO COLLEGE, IN COMING TO HARTWICK. YOU'LL FACE THE OBSTACLES MY DAD FACED, AND NEW TYPES OF OBSTACLES HE COULDN'T HAVE IMAGINED.

 MAKING. YOUR PROFESSORS, THE STAFF, YOUR CLASSMATES,

 YOUR TEAMMATES, YOUR CLUB COLLEAGUES -- WILL CHALLENGE

 YOU TO THINK CRITICALLY AND THINK DIFFERENTLY. YOU'LL BE

 GIVEN THE OPPORTUNITY TO CONDUCT RESEARCH, TRAVEL THE

 WORLD, EXPLORE CAREERS, ALL OF WHICH WILL PREPARE YOU TO

 SUCCEED IN A RAPIDLY EVOLVING AND COMPLEX WORLD.
- 2. YOU DESERVE TO BE HERE. YOU BELONG, AND YOU HAVE WITHIN
 YOU WHAT IT TAKES TO MAKE IT THROUGH THE CHALLENGES
 THAT YOU WILL CERTAINLY CONFRONT ALONG THE WAY.
- 3. THE COLLECTIVE "WE" AT HARTWICK ARE HERE FOR YOU. TO ENSURE YOU ESTABLISH AND PERSIST ON YOUR INDIVIDUALIZED FLIGHTPATH. WE WILL BE THERE WHEN YOU FALL AND WE WILL HELP YOU RIGHT BACK UP SO YOU KEEP WALKING THAT PATH.

AND, IF YOU SEE ME ON CAMPUS AND FEEL LIKE YOU NEED A JOLT OF ENERGY IN THAT MOMENT TO HELP YOU PERSIST, JUST SAY:

PRESIDENT REISBERG, I NEED THE POWER OF THE RING. I'M JUST A FIST BUMP AWAY.
