The IRS **Data Retrieval Tool** (IRS DRT) allows students and parents who filed a U.S. tax return with the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) to access the IRS tax return information needed to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA®) and to transfer the data directly into their FAFSA application.

Not everyone will be able to use this process due to a variety of different reasons. You may need to manually enter the tax information on your FAFSA.

Do not close the tab or your browser. It may take a minute or two for the process to work. Once the transfer is complete, it should take you to the page that asks, "What was your adjusted gross income for 2021?" Directly below that question should say, "Transferred from the IRS." You can then click on "Continue" to complete the rest of your FAFSA.

Limited information is transferred using the IRS DRT process. You may still need to provide tax data such as Income earned from work.
