The campus network provides cable TV access, wired and wireless Internet access. Hartwick's Stevens-German Library offers a collection of books, periodicals, microforms and films housed on our shelves and electronic resources accessible via the Internet. The Library's collection includes 209,301 books, 4,566 E-books, 59 digital databases, 3,267 media, 1,392 printed serials and 39,000 electronic serials.

Residential Facilities

Hartwick students other than local residents are required to live in College housing. Housing options include traditional residence halls, suites, apartments and townhouse apartments and the College's Pine Lake Environmental Campus, located eight miles from the main campus. Number of beds available on campus is 1,274.
