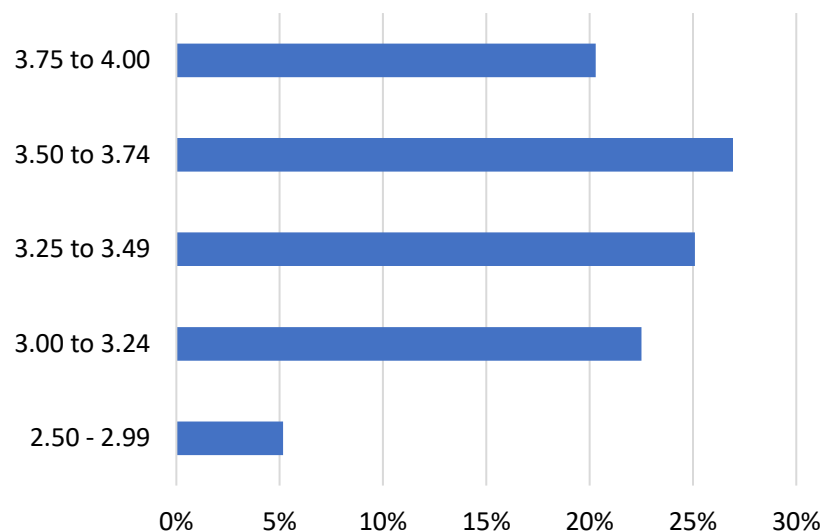

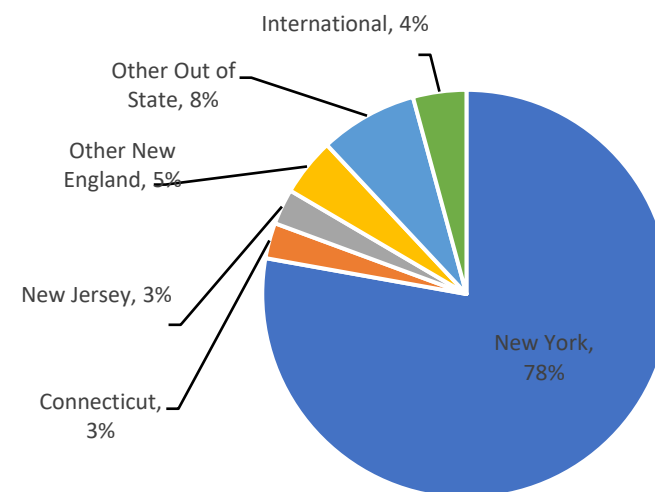
Percent of First Year Students in Each HS GPA Range - Class of 2028

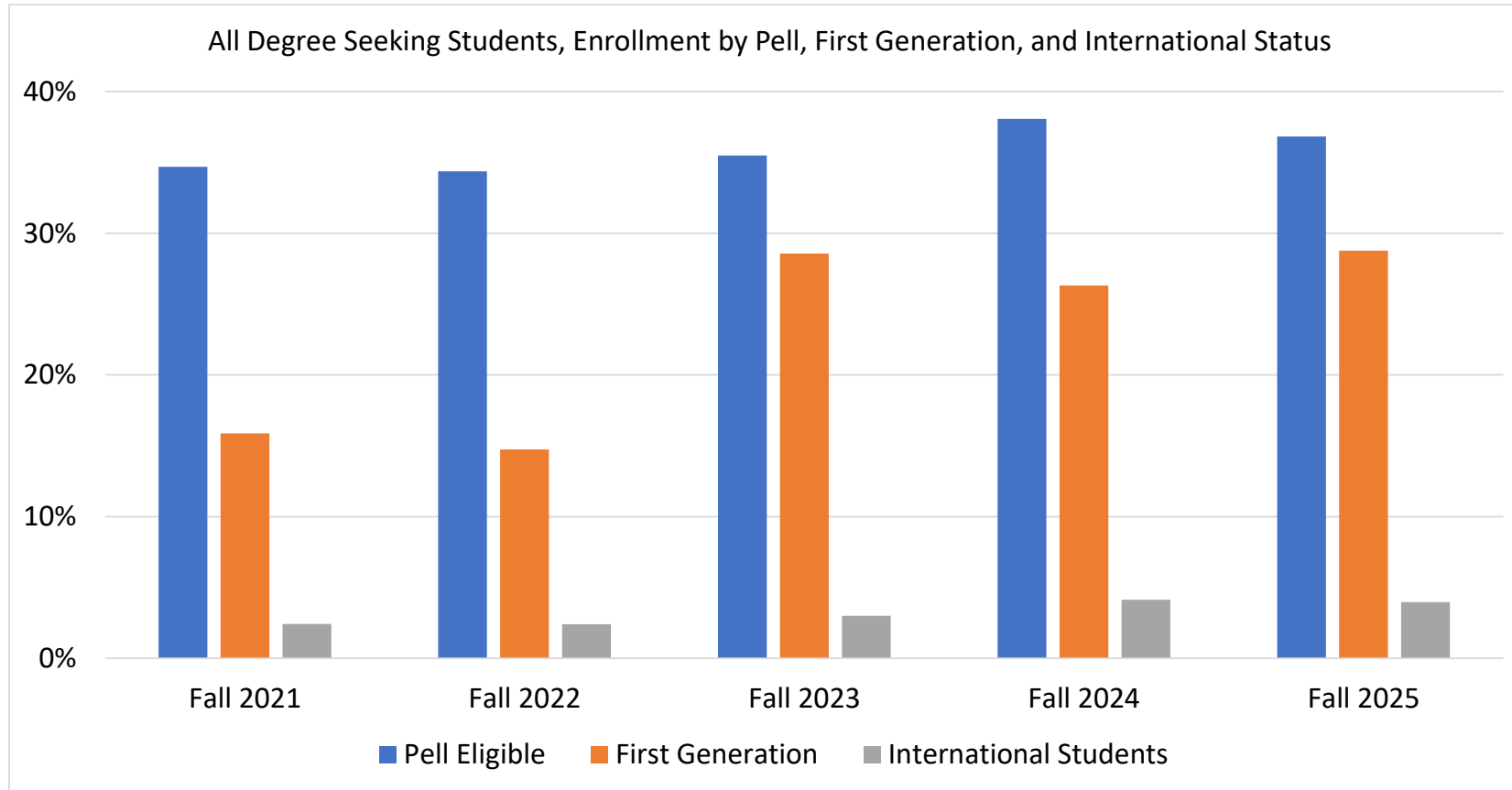

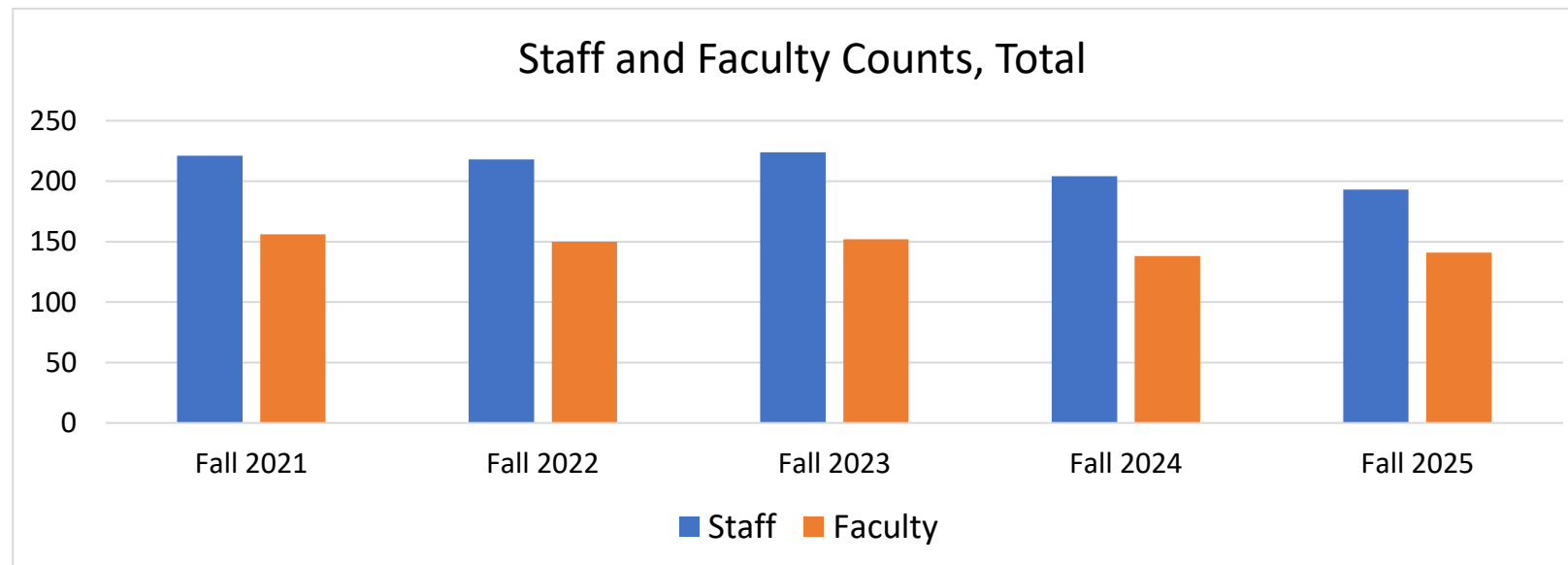

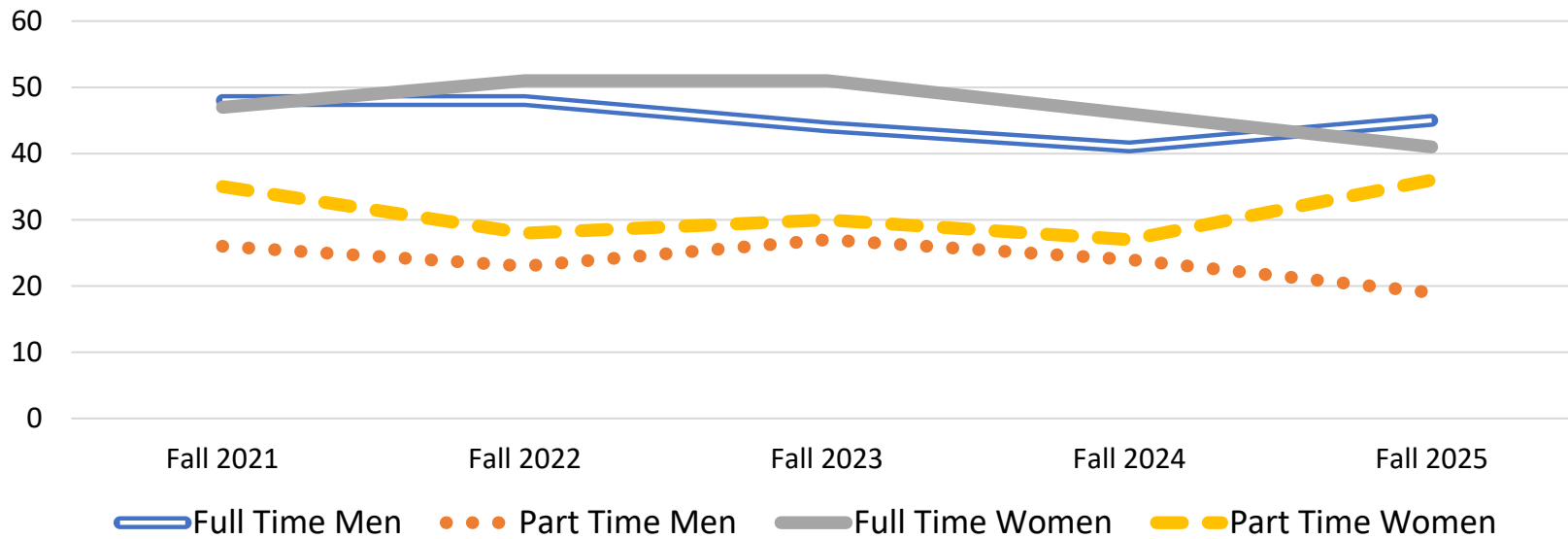

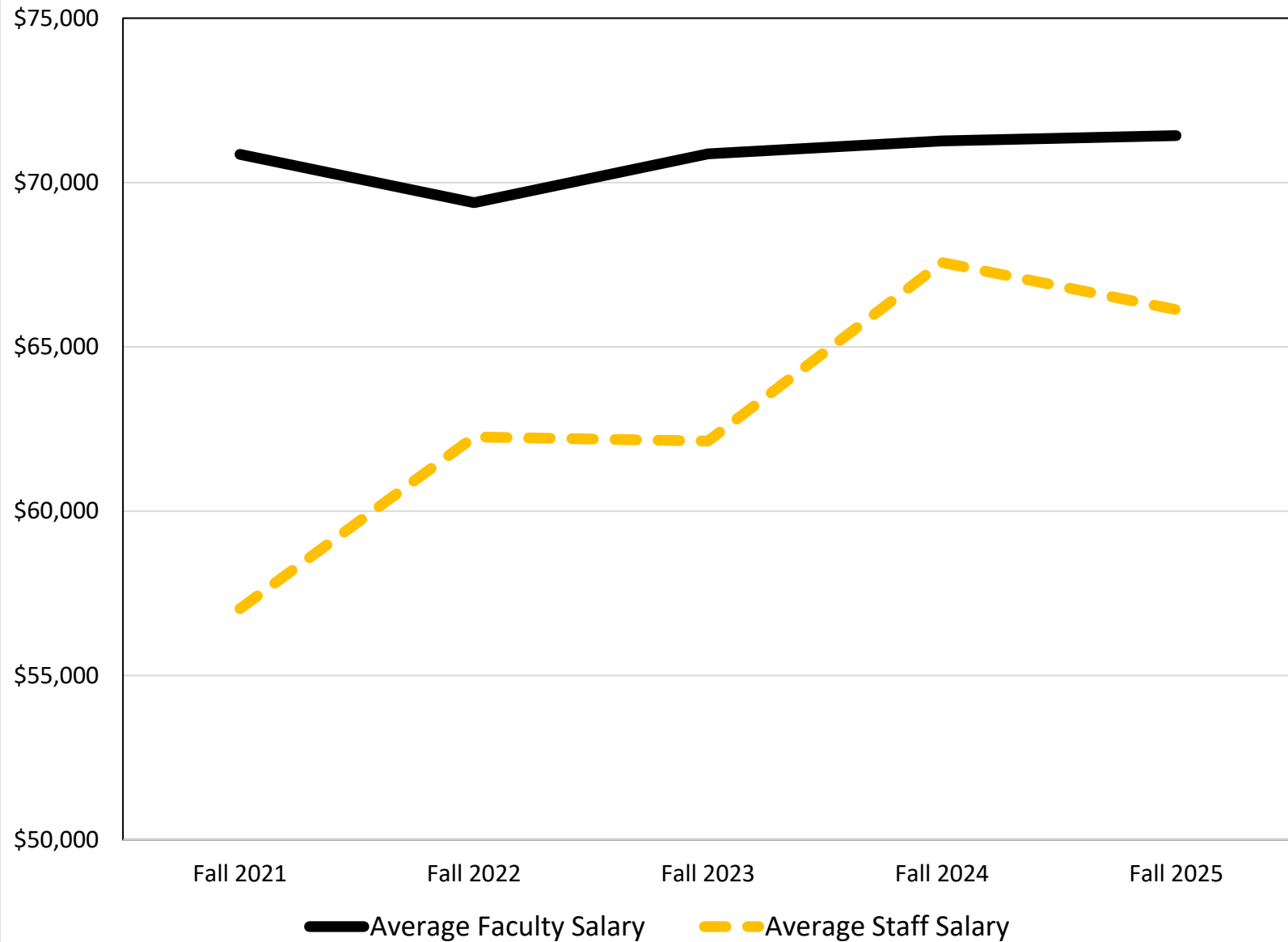

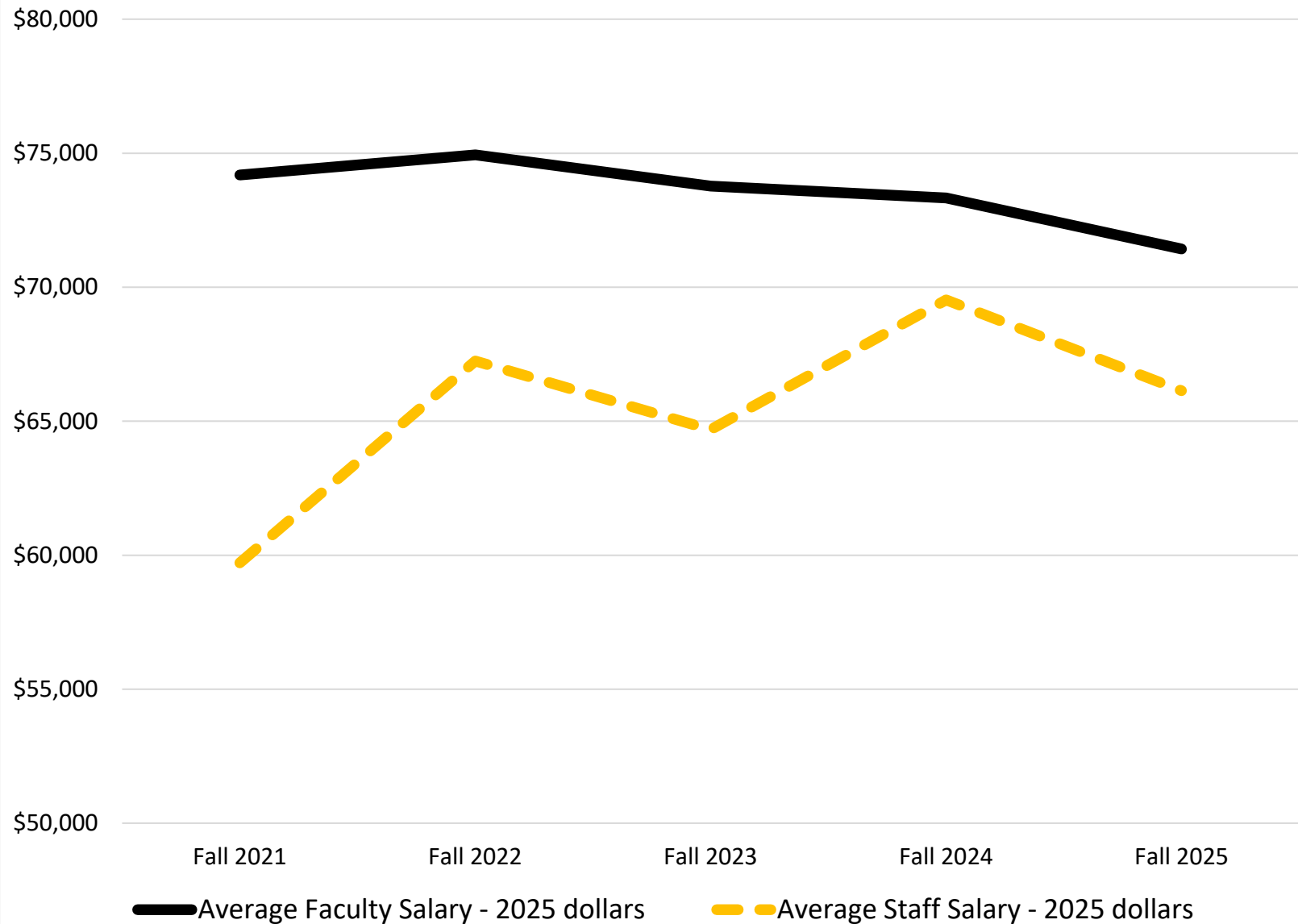

Staff & Faculty Salaries (constant dollars)



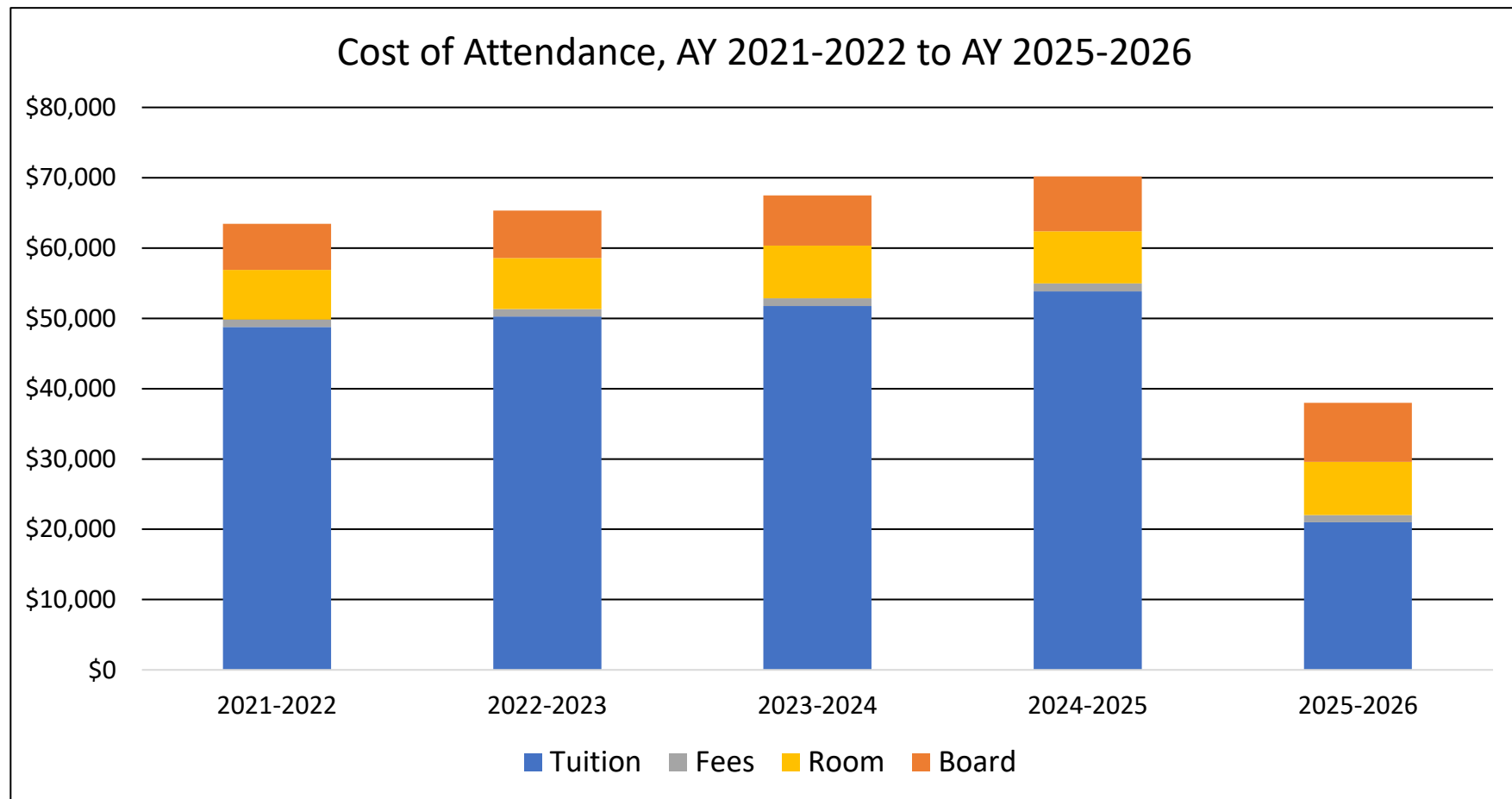

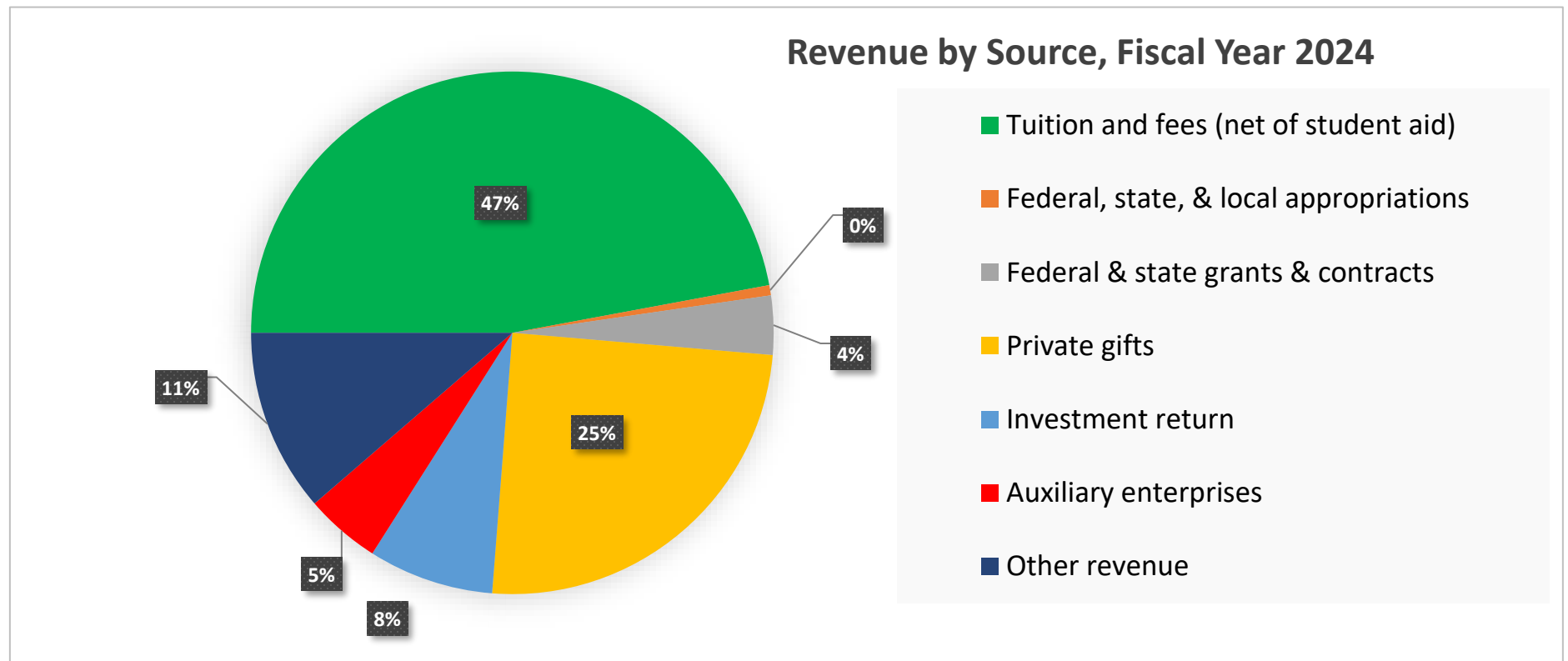

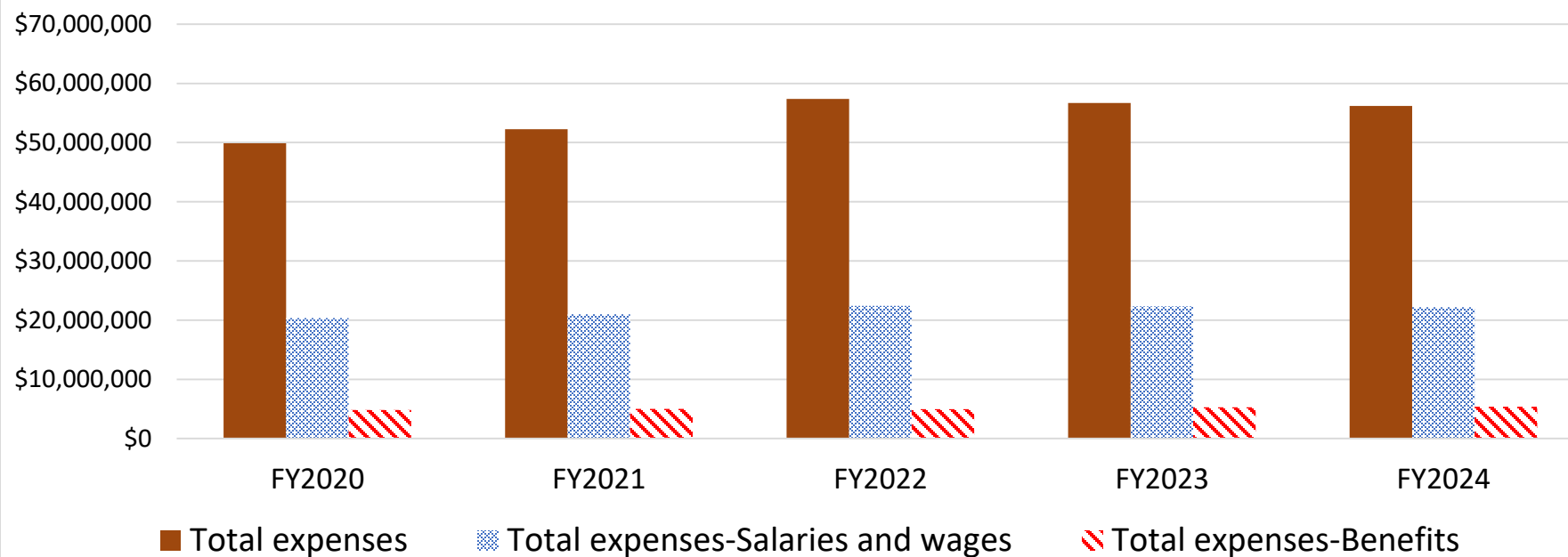
